Contact Centre between Swiss and Immigrants

The Contact Centre between Swiss and Immigrants (CCSI-Geneva) works toward defending migrants' rights. It advocates a society that treats all the persons that compose and contribute to it as equals, regardless of their national origin.

CCSI supports migrants in various areas. Its three individual consultations are:

- Consultation for «Childhood, education and health»: provides social support and defends the rights of families with undocumented children in pre-school or primary school age, from 0 to 12 years old (health insurance, family benefits, help for finding childcare solutions, school meals, etc.).
- Consultation for «Residence permits»: provides help and advice for any procedures linked to requesting or prolonging permits (residency permit, family reunification, anticipated settlement permit, etc.).
- Consultation for « Social insurance »: provides help and advice on procedures related to social insurances for migrants, particularly for those who have lost the capacity to work because of an illness or accident.
